



#### YouthWorks Summer 2020 Mission Trip Update (April 16, 2020)

First, let me say thank you so much for your quick and honest responses. This has been an impossibly hard decision! So many times during this pandemic I find myself falling back into the Psalms. Psalm 46:1-2, "God is our refuge and strength, our very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth should change." We are currently living in a time where nothing is certain, except that God is our strength! What could be better than that?

With all that said, after multiple conversations with YouthWorks, the cancellation of ASP, and majority of the votes from parents, we have made the very impossible decision to cancel our YouthWorks 2020 Mission Trip. We are saddened, but know and trust that the Lord has a plan that is bigger than our human vision. So here is what that means:

- Your deposits will be returned. However, please be patient. We will officially put the cancellation in with YouthWorks. They will start to process the payment and once we receive our refund, we will work with the church office to mail checks to all of you. We will send you a heads up once checks are in the mail.
- We will be looking into doing some sort of local, at-home project during the summer, if the time comes where it is safe to participate in larger groups. We will also be coordinating with the ASP group as they are also saddened by the loss of their trip as well.

Dear RLS Families,

You may be aware that yesterday, April 23, Governor Roy Cooper extended the "Stay at Home" Order for NC until May 8. Today, he ordered all NC Public Schools to remain physically closed through the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year.

The RLS Board of Directors has been discussing this eventuality and has determined that **RLS WILL FOLLOW** the Governor's Executive Order and **NOT PHYSICALLY OPEN** our school doors for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year. We will work to put into place Distance Learning (DL) "Phase #3" for May 18 until the end of scheduled school on June 5.

Very shortly we will present what DL Phase #3 will look like. Though we have been discussing this already, we have our "Phase #2" plan for Distance Learning (DL) in place until May 15, so there is time for us to make sure of the next steps without a "rush" to do so. We appreciate your patience.

I thank you for your support of our teachers and staff as they have worked to support you and your family through this unprecedented time. God often uses difficult or trying circumstances in our lives to refine and teach us. I know that He does not wish us ill or difficulties, but they come in life. What is so amazing about our God is that He uses these difficulties for our betterment in ways that usually are incomprehensible to us during the time of trial.

Please reach out to us if we can be of assistance to you and know that the patience and understanding we are asking for ourselves we extend to you as well. Thank you for your partnership.
