Dear family and friends,

Greetings in the name of the Triune God who blesses us with the gift of His Spirit, whom we worship and adore again this Pentecost Sunday!

This is a reminder for all of you that this Sunday, May 31, we plan to live stream worship content in the church sanctuary beginning at 9 AM. Because the worship content is "live," it will not be immediately available for viewing afterward as has been the case with our pre-produced worship content up until now. In case you miss the service at 9, please check back or activate your YouTube app notifications to alert you to the video posting. Worship content will be edited and re-posted for remote viewing later on in the day or on Monday.

If you signed up for small group in-person reception of Holy Communion on the afternoon of May 31, we ask the following:

- If you arrive early, please remain in your car until 5 minutes prior to your scheduled worship time.
- Please enter by the narthex door, which will be open; the service will begin as promptly as possible. (There will be no need to handle either a hymnal or bulletin.)
- All worshipers, except for those under 2 years of age or otherwise unable to oversee their own personal use of a face mask, should enter the sanctuary wearing a face covering; face masks will of course be removed prior to reception of the Lord's Supper.
- If you need to use the restroom while in the building, please notify a staff member.
- Please exit and return to the parking lot by way of the office entrance (this will be locked for anyone entering the church from the outside).

I stand by ready to answer any questions that you might have. A very blessed Pentecost Sunday to all of you!

The day of Pentecost is the birthday of the Christian Church. This celebration takes place 50 days after Easter (the word Pentecost means 50th day). On this day, the Holy Spirit breathed upon men and women from around the world and sent them to share the wonderful news of God's love for the world.

The "tongues of fire" that were seen above the heads of the disciples were a sign of God's presence, just as God used fire as a sign of His presence in the Old Testament. He spoke to Moses from a burning bush, then He lighted the way for the Israelites as a pillar of fire at night as they fled Egypt for the Promised Land. This is why we celebrate Pentecost with the color red.

Life For Uganda Update

Covid-19 continues to rule over our routines and our best laid plans and because of this, the mission team which was scheduled to travel to Uganda this year will not be able to make the journey. Travel restrictions will remain in place in both the US and Uganda for the foreseeable future, therefore Life For Uganda is working with the Lutheran Church of Uganda (LCU) to reschedule in 2021. While we're disappointed, we're also finding ways to support the LCU in their extensive Covid-19 relief efforts. Food insecurity, while normally an issue in rural areas, has become a serious threat in urban areas because of the lack of work or inability to move about, and because food prices have skyrocketed. Access to food, and sanitation supplies has become challenging for

thousands of Ugandans and the LCU has been organizing support across the entire country. Life For Uganda has sent a significant portion of the funds intended for our travel to the LCU to be used for Covid-19 relief. Please remember that it's because of the continued and faithful commitment of RLC that Life For Uganda is able to raise funds for our travel and work. We thank you for this unwavering support and we're blessed to provide some assistance to the LCU, even if it's from this great distance.


