

You are finding me in your Inbox quite often these days! I pray that these regular updates about worship opportunities are a gentle reminder that our ministry goes on throughout these summer months and we endeavor to serve you and our community as our loving God provides us that opportunity.

First off, please don't forget that Holy Communion will again be live streamed this Sunday at 9 AM. As always, you have the option of receiving the sacrament in person at Resurrection in groups of 10 or fewer people and can sign up for that opportunity at the following link: https://www.signupgenius.com/go/10c0d4dabae2eabff2-holy.

Our plan for the month of August is to expand the current option for small group reception of Holy Communion to 75 people per service, starting over the weekend of August 15/16. Opportunities for in-person worship will be offered on Saturday, August 15 at 6 PM and Sunday, August 16 at 8 AM in the sanctuary of the main building, and Sunday, August 16 at 10:45 AM in the Family Life Center. Our weekly worship live stream will continue, but will move from the current 9 AM slot to 9:30 AM beginning August 2. More information about this will be forthcoming in the days ahead. I just wanted to give you a heads up now, so that you are looking for information about this in our weekly announcements and our church's social media sites.

- 12. Special thanks to Tim Hiteshew and the Resurrection Service Project volunteers for helping members in need of outdoor home assistance.


