Pastor's Corner, Week of September 6 - September 12, 2020

Dear Resurrection friends and brothers and sisters in Christ,

Last week during weekend worship services Vicar Alan Shaw led us into Part 1 of a two-part focus on the forgiveness of sins: the gift of forgiveness that is ours in Christ Jesus. This week we expand on that focus by considering the privilege God gives us in granting forgiveness to one another.

A two-week focus on forgiveness comes at a good time, don't you think? Life is challenging enough, just as it is; add the Covid crisis to the mix and it can seem as if someone has turned up the heat on us...ordinary disagreements arrive at the boiling point before we even realize what is happening! It's not by accident that our two-part focus on forgiveness starts with the gift of forgiveness we ourselves receive freely and completely in God's dear Son Jesus Christ. The only One who can forgive and forget sins, the only One who can remove our own transgressions from us "as far as the East is from the West" (Psalm 103:12) has already done so! *Therefore* we are able to "breathe grace out" for others...we have already breathed it in for ourselves! Forgiving others does not mean we will, forever after, have warm fuzzy feelings about them. It does not mean that we will necessarily forget what they have done to us. And it in no way condones wrongdoing. Rather, forgiveness recognizes that there is a debt owed, but decides to release another person from that debt rather than go through the trouble of keeping track of it and reliving the pain associated with it. This kind of forgiveness is only possible with the help God gives.

If you, like me, struggle with the need to forgive and call on God's strength in the midst of any conflict you're facing today, I invite you to join me and all of us at Resurrection as we gather this weekend to seek that strength together. Don't forget that starting September 20, we will begin two worship live streams: one at 8 AM and one at 10:45 AM. The 9:30 live stream will be discontinued that week. In its place will be a team-led Bible class offered via Zoom for all members of the Resurrection community: Max Lucado's *Unshakable Hope: Building Our Lives on the Promises of God*. Let's get back into the groove of Sunday morning Bible study, together! I'll write more about this new opportunity in next week's Pastor's Corner.

St. Paul sends this final greeting to the church at Corinth: "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ...and the love of God...and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit, be with you all!" (2 Cor. 13:14). May this benediction keep our focus on God's strength--and not our own--as we call upon the grace of God to "forgive [one another] from [our] heart" (Matt 18:35).

Fundraising for the Youth!

Due to Covid, Scrip will be the main source of funding for RLC Youth Programs which includes scholarships, lowering the cost of mission trips/events, and updating resources.

The Scrip program has been a part of RLC for 12 years. For families, you can choose to have your profits set aside specifically for *your* youth. So, 50% of the proceed goes to the church and 50% goes straight into your student account. For others, you can designate the other 50% to help specific youth or the entire youth program.

The typical NYG trip without fundraising or Scrip funds costs \$1,400/person. That's a lot! For those that participate actively with Scrip, receive \$250 of scholarship money from Scrip **PLUS** you get to use whatever money was saved up in their student accounts. First payment for the 2022 NYG will be August 2021! That is not that far away, but leaves plenty of time to sign up and start saving money now!

It has never been easier as Scrip has launched a brand new app (Raise Right), which is super easy to use and eliminates the need for physical gift cards. Such an easy way to fundraise and benefit your youth in the process!

Western Wake Crisis Ministry

Helping Families Stay In Their Homes

Before Covid-19, we were spending about \$6-8,000 a month on rental and utility assistance and most households only needed a little help to get them through difficult time. Now families are coming to us who are behind by thousands of dollars and facing imminent eviction or have already been evicted and are living in a hotel or sleeping in a car. During June, July, and August we spent between \$15,000-\$20,000 per month to keep our neighbors safely housed. Each month the needs are increasing so much that we have now created a new "Street Outreach" program to address the supports needed to help those who are experiencing homelessness to get connected to services that can help with shelter and re-housing, not just crisis assistance.

As I shared at the congregational Zoom meeting, in August's newsletter, and previous RLC's announcements, the positive aspects of a period of '**pause**' for RLP will allow us:

- 🖑 TIME to **'pause,'** review, and renew our program.
- **TIME:** RLP intends to **return** in 2021-22 with a restored and refreshed program; a preschool program offered in this community since 1984 and will continue to grow stronger.
- TIME to prepare for enrollment to start in December for the 2021-22 preschool year (September 2021-May 2022).
- TIME to **plan** and hopefully be able to offer Spring 2021 and/or Summer 2021 Camps, as we monitor the pandemic.

Preparations for any upcoming year of preschool are on-going. Calendars for the *next* preschool year are drafted shortly after we start a preschool year. In October- planning of class offerings begins; November- tuition/registration fees are determined, and brochures are published; December- registration opens for church members; January- registration for the public begins. Tours generally start in January; however, they are offered whenever a family inquires.

I am humbled by the support of my church family. Thank you for reaching out, sharing reassuring and encouraging words, and covering me, the staff, the children, and their families, with your prayers.
