

Pastor's Corner, Week of September 27 - October 3, 2020

Dear Resurrection friends and brothers and sisters in Christ,

There is an image of overflowing joy in our text for this Sunday. Yes, it is voiced by St. Paul, who still sits languishing in prison. Paul doesn't minimize life's present challenges...either for himself or his readers. Yet he speaks as one who knows how his life's story will end. And knowing the cosmic events centered on the Son of God who came down from heaven "emptying Himself" to give up His life on a cross for us...One who is now worthy of praise from all living beings...Paul invites his listeners not to look down, but up: "Rejoice with me!" (Philippians 2:18), he writes. His joy in contagious!

This week we rejoice together as we take advantage of opportunities to worship both in person (sign up at: http://www.rlcary.org/about-us/online-worship/). The 8 AM live stream on Sunday will stay up all morning. Holy Communion will be celebrated on Saturday night (Sept 26) at 6 PM and Sunday (Sept 27) at 10:45 AM. If you plan to attend in person, please use the sign up genius at the link above so that we are prepared to welcome you.

I invite you to keep the celebration going all week long as you enjoy a free (furnished by RLC) subscription to RightNow Media (RNM). RNM is a kind of "Christian Netflix" which you can stream on your personal device or Roku/Apple television. There is content for children, youth, married couples, single adults...as well as content grouped by topic (e.g., the video series "Race in America," shown last month to our Southeastern District congregations during an online conversation on race). Though the content on this service is not a production of our own synodical publisher, you will find it encouraging and helpful for your faith journey... especially for this time that we are not all able to gather in person. Check your Inbox Sunday evening and get connected!

Saturday Oct 4-5 will be our Service Weekend at RLC, with a focus on service opportunities. You will hear the personal stories of two RLC members serving in the community, see the quilts produced by RLC "Piecemakers" (our church's quilting group) that we will be dedicating, and be invited to take part in one of the many service opportunities available to you and your family even during the current Covid-19 crisis. Rejoicing is not just an attitude of the heart. It can't help but move us to action! What a privilege it is to serve others with the joy of Christ.

Finally, I want to let everyone know that the specific, joy-inducing components of Christianity will be my focus in an upcoming Wednesday evening Zoom class on the basics of the Christian faith. If you've never been instructed in our church's teachings (or if you have, and would like to review), then this is something you won't want to miss. "Rejoice in the Lord always! Again I will say, rejoice!" (4:11). In life there will always be something worthy of our concern and attention, of that we can be sure. But there will also always something about God that we can celebrate each day. 

Ignite (6th-8th grades)

Happy Fall! Hope everyone is enjoying the cooler weather. During the Fall, one of our Ignite activities that is always a favorite with the youth is the Campfire/S'mores Night. After figuring out logistics, making sure CDC guidelines are followed, and running through a mock event, we are ready! I will be splitting the groups into 6th grade one night and 7th-8th grade another, due to the number of youth in each grade level and the limited space in each event. If the event is full, please join the waitlist. This helps if I have cancellations, and also gives me an idea of how many youth want to attend, for when I can increase my numbers.

6th Grade - Friday, October 9 from 6:30-8:00 pm, 7th-8th Grade - Friday, October 16 from 6:30-8:00 pm - RLC Parking Lot

- 12 Youth (must be signed up and have forms filled out before event)
- Youth need to bring a **chair** to sit (these will be placed at least 6 ft. apart and will be the only place that masks will be taken off) and a **water bottle**.
- 3 to 4 youth will be roasting marshmallows at a time using their own 3 foot bamboo skewers.
- All s'mores fixings will be individually bagged and kids will prepare their own s'more. (ziplock bag will contain graham cracker, marshmallow, and chocolate)

I will supply the skewer and individually prepared s'mores bags. Please be aware that we will not have entrance into the church building (so no bathrooms) or water fountains.

As per church requirement, during all games and other activities that the youth are not social distanced, they will be required to wear a mask.
