Pastor's Corner, Week of October 4-10, 2020



Resurrection friends and brothers and sisters in Christ,

This weekend we invite all to celebrate the Spirit of service at RLC and to live out the power of Jesus' resurrection with offerings of time for one another and our community. We will be dedicating quilts made by RLC Piecemakers to Lutheran World Relief and sharing ways you can safely get involved in service projects to our church community and beyond...even during COVID. Either sign up to worship in person (at: <u>http://www.rlcary.org/about-us/in-person-worship</u>) or online (<u>http://www.rlcary.org/about-us/online-worship</u>). Holy Communion will be celebrated Saturday evening at 6 PM and Sunday morning at 8 AM. The Sunday 10:45 AM live stream will stay up on our YouTube channel. If you plan to attend in person, please use the appropriate sign up genius at the link above or be prepared to sign in upon arriving at the sanctuary entrance. This allows us to prepare for those attending and to do contact tracing, in the unlikely event that it should become necessary.

We're gathering a nice group of folks together for my six-week introduction/review of the main doctrines of the Christian faith,



starting October 7, entitled "This Is the Church." The focus of the class will be on the core doctrines of the Christian faith (including the Ten Commandments, Apostles' Creed, Lord's Prayer, Holy Baptism, Confession, and the Lord's Supper), understanding how/why they occur in our worship life and what makes Christianity different from all other world religions. Our textbooks will be the Bible and Luther's Small Catechism (available for those taking part to pick up from the church office next week). Be prepared for a class that will last up to 90 minutes and will be accessible via Zoom. Both newcomers and veterans of the faith are welcome to take part! This past Wednesday you should have received a survey asking for your feedback regarding a proposed change to our current worship schedule. This is a follow up to the summary provided to the congregation this past summer. Please be sure to read the accompanying documents and complete the survey. This information will be invaluable to me and the members of our leadership team at RLC in deciding what sort of recommendation to make for the congregation's vote later this fall. I'm so grateful for the work of the Focus Group in thinking through the options available to us.

Finally, let me close by saying that next week I'll have a list of apps for your devices that will make God's Word even more widely available to you and the members of your family.
