

Pastor's Corner, Week of October 25-31, 2020



Dear Resurrection friends and brothers and sisters in Christ,

Ok, so who is that guy up on the church sign? That's Martin Luther, of course! This Playmobile figure of the great reformer was gifted to me by a church member several years ago. What does it say in the book Luther is holding out? "The Old Testament and the New Testament, translated by Dr. Martin Luther." I love it that Resurrection is a community of faith that values God's Word and provides so many opportunities to be in God's Word...even during COVID (for a list of current offerings, click here). This week we celebrate our church's heritage and the blessing of the Holy Spirit to be constantly at work reforming you and me through God's Holy Word. The message of our need and God's rescue may at times take us by surprise...but it is the very Bread of Life that nourishes our souls.

Whether you're with us in person or in spirit this weekend, I know you'll join me in celebrating that Jesus' Word delivers the Truth...it is a Truth that sets us free! (John 8:32). Either sign up to worship in person at this link or click here to retrieve your electronic bulletin and worship online. Holy Communion will be celebrated Saturday evening (in-person only) in a service that recalls Luther's Mass, beginning at 6 PM. The Sunday morning 8 AM in-person service will be live streamed and stay up on our YouTube channel. Holy Communion will be offered at the 10:45 AM service and be available via live stream at that time only. Please note that this Sunday we are introducing limited congregational unison singing in all services. There will also be recorded instrumental and choral music played in the Saturday evening and Sunday morning early services. As always, if you plan to attend in person, please use the appropriate sign up genius at the link above or be prepared to sign in upon arriving at the sanctuary entrance. This allows us to prepare for those attending and do contact tracing, in the unlikely event that it should become necessary.

Don't forget that every month Holy Communion will continue to be made available...

- Every Saturday night at 6 PM;
- Every first and third Sunday at 8 AM;
- Every second, fourth, and fifth Sunday at 10:45 AM.

Next week (Oct 31/Nov 1) we will celebrate "All Saints Sunday". Be on the look out for a letter inviting you to bring pictures that remind you of a loved one who has been called home to heaven for display on our "Table of Remembrance" near the sanctuary entrance, in all services. The names of church members who have been called home to heaven in the last 12 months will be read aloud during worship. Then, on the weekend of November 7-8, I invite you to give thanks to God for all God has gifted you in the area of time, talent, and treasure. This will be RLC's Christian Stewardship Weekend. Anyone choosing to do so may submit an anonymous pledge for financial contributions to be submitted during a dedication of pledges in all services. More about that in next week's letter.

These are uncertain times. I encourage you to continue following these emails for updates. Please know that we continue to monitor the conditions for COVID in our county and will take appropriate measures to limit in-person activities should that become necessary. What better time than today to remember and celebrate that "A Mighty Fortress Is Our God"? Though so much in the world changes all around us, "God's Word forever shall abide" (*LSB*, 657).




