

Pastor's Corner — Week of February 7-13, 2021



Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

I'm not a diehard NFL fan, but it's hard not to get caught up in the hoopla surrounding the big game this Sunday. Even if the Patriots or Buccaneers are not your team, you can't help but be impressed by "Old Man Tom Brady" as he takes the field for this, his tenth Super Bowl. Win or lose this year, Brady's longevity and tenacity in the game can in a way remind us of the runner in our Epistle reading. The runner in our text gives a picture of endurance and grace under pressure. Paul applies this image to the follower of Christ: he does not run aimlessly...but with his eyes on the prize (9:25-27) he continues to sacrifice out of love for others, even when it hurts to do so. It would be easy to ignore the needs around us, become distracted, discouraged or just "go with the flow." The Spirit of God keeps our feet moving and our eyes fixed on Jesus. We run in life because He first ran for us!

Here's a bit of news this week:

- The Call Committee and I are in the process of interviewing candidates for Associate Pastor at Concordia Seminary this week. Please continue to keep our conversations with these young men and the unfolding process in your prayers.
- All regular in-person services (6 PM Saturday, 8 AM & 11 AM Sunday) will not gather in person this weekend (February 6/7). Instead, there will be one weekly live stream starting at 8 AM and remaining active on our YouTube channel after the 8-9 AM hour. Things in our county are looking better, but remain at the high end of "critical." We will decide after this weekend whether or not to extend the pause or resume in-person events. - RLC missionaries serving in Uganda, Megan and Mark Mantey, will be with us on Sunday! They will assist with the sermon message during worship and then speak at greater length during the Sunday School hour. Please join us and hear about what God is doing in Uganda as we welcome the Mantey's back to Cary!
- Ashes for Ash Wednesday will be made available this year for anyone to pick up for remote worship viewing, starting Wednesday, February 10. We will provide small, disposable containers (one per family unit) for you to receive from church and use at home during our Ash Wednesday live stream.
- Circumstances remain very fluid for all church activities during this winter season. I urge you to check out any and all church events as listed on our church calendar, which is constantly updated online. You can [find it by clicking here](#).

I close with another image of runners, this time from our appointed Old Testament reading: "Have you not known? Have you not heard? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He does not faint or grow weary; his understanding is unsearchable. He gives power to the faint, and to him who has no might he increases strength. Even youths shall faint and be weary, and young men shall fall exhausted; but they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint" (40:28-31).

Whether running weary, or running strong, we know the outcome of the race. We do not faint...but living in joy we strive to live as servants to all. Privileged to be in the race with all of you!



Both newcomers and veterans of the faith are welcome to take part!



Mark and Megan Mantey serve the Lord through The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS) as career missionaries in Uganda. Mark serves as project manager for the seminary, managing the financial aspects and collaborating in the creation of a long-term business plan. As an instructor of Christian education and counseling, Megan teaches classes at the seminary and advises on its program development. Mark and Megan are also grateful to be involved in the daily life of the local community and the Lutheran Church of Uganda (LCU). Through these interactions, they build partnerships that assist

the LCU in sharing the love of Christ and proclaiming the Gospel.

Mark has roots in Wisconsin and Iowa, but grew up in Wilmington, N.C. Right now, he is studying accounting at Colorado State University. Prior to becoming a missionary in Uganda, Mark worked for 20 years in a family business, primarily as the vice-president of sales. When Mark is not working, he enjoys watching DIY programs for whatever project he is thinking about at that moment. He and Megan also like exploring new places together, as well as finding humor in everyday situations.

Megan (Flannery) was born in southern California and grew up in different parts of the western United States. She received her bachelor's degree in Christian education and her director of Christian education (DCE) certification from Concordia University, Portland, Ore. She earned her master's degree in mental health counseling from Campbell University, Buies Creek, N.C. Megan was a DCE in North Carolina and Virginia, as well as a mental health counselor before serving in Uganda. Megan also serves as coordinator for Member Care for the LCMS Africa region's missionary families and maintains a part-time counseling clinic in Jinja, Uganda.

Pray for the Mantey's as they serve the Lord's people in Uganda through their roles in project management and teaching. We are providing Sunday School virtually for children through 8th grade. Everything is on the website at rlcary.org, under Ministries on the **Sunday School for Kids** webpage.


