

## Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

The photo you see above popped up in a free license database I use and depicts the word "disappointment." As you can see, it shows a man looking down and with regret, while a chalkboard drawing behind him depicts the muscles and inner strength he feels he needs. To me, that is the perfect prelude for this Third Sunday of Easter. Last week we focused on God's free invitation to confess our sins and receive forgiveness. But that raises the question: if I'm a sinner--even a forgiven one--what is God able to do with me for good? How can God use someone like me to make the world a better place...especially when I fall down in life time and time again? The answer? We find it in the first letter of John this week: The crucified yet risen Son of God Jesus Christ brings us everlasting hope. We have been called (and we are) the very children of the God of the universe! And so the Christian faith journey is not an ongoing slog with a constant focus backward: on our sins, our failures, where life has gone wrong. The risen Christ in us will help us see our sins so that we can know the peace that comes from God's forgiveness. But the Christian journey is, in the end, an adventure lived in expectation of what God is doing...a focus FORWARD on what is around the bend: new fruits of repentance, new opportunities to love those that are placed in our path, a new day and chance to write on a clean slate. All of which will one day end in a new homecoming that will feel like the ONLY homecoming we've ever known: our homecoming with our heavenly Father and loving Savior Jesus!

- There are just two more weeks left in our "Count Me In" pledge drive. I'm so grateful for so many who have already stepped up to be counted! By now you have probably seen my invitation to first-time pledgers to consider a pledge to Resurrection Lutheran Church for fiscal year 2021-2022. I'm asking for just 15 more pledges to make our goal of 50. If you didn't submit a pledge last fall and have not yet done so this year, now is the time! # **REACH OUR GOAL OF 50 PLEDGES**





2021 is shaping up to be a busy year at Resurrection. We foresee opening our church campus to a new worship and small group schedule this fall. We look forward to engaging more intentionally with our local neighborhoods in person. And, following our most recent church meeting, we have submitted call documents for one of three candidates soon-to-graduate Concordia Seminary, St. Louis as our new Associate Pastor! All of it, of course, is not possible without the prayer, love, and support of all of you.

All Resurrection members are invited to stand up and be counted. Last year our Stewardship Pledge Drive resulted in 75 of the roughly 400 households of our congregation pledging to support the mission and ministry at RLC with a portion of their income. If you or your family were one of those 75 households, thank you. You are all set! But there are at least 300 households who were not able to join us in this challenge last year. We have set a goal of adding 50 NEW pledges--people who have never made a pledge to RLC--to the 75 or so gathered last November. The pledge will be for monies spent in the period beginning July 2021 (fiscal 2022). Asking 50 out of 300 family units to stand up and be counted is a modest goal. We can do this!


