Pastor's Corner for Week of May 2-8



Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

It is that time of year that RLC youth stand up in front of the congregation and say "yes" to what others promised on their behalf on the day of the their baptism: it's Confirmation weekend! Though that is a big deal for anyone, what makes it possible is not, in the end, the measure of young person's sense of conviction or the number of his or her service hours. It is all possible because of the love of God, "perfected" or "completed" by what Jesus Christ did for all of us--the topic, as it turns out, for this upcoming 5th Sunday of Easter! Of course, our confirmands and their parents extended a lot of effort this past year to stay up to speed with confirmation instruction. I would like to especially commend the work of our Confirmation teachers: MaryAnn Unger (Confirmation 1) and Vicar Alan Shaw (Confirmation 2). Together with our small group leaders, they took on the task of imparting faith stories and inviting RLC youth to grow in their knowledge of God's Word in the midst of an enormously challenging pandemic year. In addition to leading the final year of confirmation instruction, Vicar Alan has been instrumental in organizing the youth to prepare and present their faith statements. Some have been presented in worship already. Others are being recorded and will be made available to the congregation later on. With Vicar Alan's efforts and the efforts of others who have assisted in leading Sunday School classes and Middle School youth activities (shout-out to Middle School Youth Director LeAnn Trautman), we are pleased to confirm 19 youth. We pray God's abundant grace might be poured out on each one of them as they begin this new chapter of their faith journey together.

Here is the information I have for you to know about this week:

- In case you have not yet heard, we are pleased to welcome seminarian Zachary Sarrault as our new Associate
 Pastor! Those who were in on the Zoom call yesterday had a chance to briefly meet Zach and his wife Kelsey
 after Call Day at Concordia Seminary, St. Louis. They are just as excited to join us in ministry here as we are to
 welcome them! Zach and Kelsey hail from Michigan. You can read a short letter of greeting they provided within
 this announcement.
- As if the announcement about our new Associate Pastor wasn't already wonderful news, I also received a letter from RLC Music and Worship Director Bob Unger. <u>Please click here to read.</u> We keep Pilgrim Lutheran Church's continued search for a Teacher and Minister of Music in our prayers.
- We will be transitioning some worship elements (e.g., distribution of the Lord's Supper) to practices that more closely resemble what was going on at RLC before the pandemic started, beginning May 8 and 9. Beginning May 8, all services with Holy Communion will be done with a familiar style of distribution at the communion rail. Governor Cooper's most recent press conference and executive order related to the risk of COVID-19 in the state of North Carolina was encouraging. I look forward to seeing us ease our present attendance limits in the weeks ahead. Please don't forget that we will go to three services on Sunday morning (at 8, 9:30, and 11) beginning May 30.
- <u>Sign up here for in-person worship services this Saturday and Sunday, May 1 and 2.</u> Holy Communion will be offered at 6 PM Saturday evening. Then, we will host two services on Sunday morning at 8 and 11 AM, with Holy Communion offered in the 8 AM service. In-person worshippers are, as of this writing, still limited to 75 persons per service. Please use the Sign Up genius at the link above to indicate your plans to attend. (Usually we would offer smaller services of Holy Communion for groups of 10 or fewer at 12:30 PM, but due to a private baptism at 12:30 this weekend, small group Holy Communion on May 2 will not be available.)

- Due to the Rite of Confirmation and worship service for RLC confirmands and their families scheduled for Sunday at 9:30, our Adult Bible Class "Race and the Gospel" will be on vacation this week. Please be on the lookout for the Zoom invitation as we gather again for Session 3 of the study "Justice and the Church" on May 9.
- New "Welcome to Resurrection" classes will be held via Zoom starting May 8 at 9 AM. If you know anyone who might be interested in finding out more about our faith community, please let us know (or have them contact the church office) at <u>office@rlcary.org</u>.
- The "Count Me In" pledge drive ends this weekend. Our current pledges stand at 46--just 4 shy of our goal of 50. If you didn't submit a pledge last fall and have not yet done so this year, there are still a few more days left to do so. Your pledge is anonymous, is between just you and God, and is intended as merely one way you can challenge yourself to rely on God's abundant provision for you in your life. <u>You may submit your pledge form online by clicking here.</u>

God's once-and-for-all sacrifice through God's Son, Jesus Christ, is perfect and complete. Knowing and celebrating this gift of "perfect love" that casts out all fear (1 John 4:18), it is our privilege to confess and live out a love unlike any other! God be with us all as we take part in that calling again this week.

COUNT ME IN! REACH OUR GOAL OF 50 PLEDGES





2021 is shaping up to be a busy year at Resurrection. We foresee opening our church campus to a new worship and small group schedule this fall. We look forward to engaging more intentionally with our local neighborhoods in person. And, following our most recent church meeting, we have submitted call documents for one of three candidates soonto-graduate Concordia Seminary, St. Louis as our new Associate Pastor! All of it, of course, is not possible without the prayer, love, and support of all of you.

All Resurrection members are invited to stand up and be counted. Last year our Stewardship Pledge Drive resulted in 75 of the roughly 400 households of our congregation pledging to support the mission and ministry at RLC with a portion of their income. If you or your family were one of those 75 households, thank you. You are all set! But there are at least 300 households who were not able to join us in this challenge last year. **We have set a goal of adding 50 NEW pledges--people who have never made a pledge to RLC**--to the 75 or so gathered last November. The pledge will be for monies spent in the period beginning July 2021 (fiscal 2022). Asking 50 out of 300 family units to stand up and be counted is a modest goal. We can do this!
