Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

I'll never forget my "5 minutes of fame" as a freshman in college. The year was 1980. I was asked to be part of an anniversary celebration commemorating the move of Virginia's capital from Williamsburg to Richmond, VA that involved my college's canoe team. A dozen or so of us were asked to paddle a war canoe all the way from Williamsburg to Richmond to celebrate the 200th anniversary of the original event. It was enormous fun--though excruciatingly difficult--but we made it. We made it all the way up the James River...but only because we had seasoned veterans on our team who carried neophyte freshmen like me all 100 miles! St. John writes in our text today: "God's commandments are not burdensome, for whatever is born of God conquers the world... Who is it that conquers the world but the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?" (5:4–5). You and I share in a victory that we celebrate this weekend. But love that "conquers" or "overcomes the world" was never anything that WE made happen! The winning spirit that enables us to persever in times of trial comes from the outside in, from the very ground of Love itself. It is because of Jesus' victory, testified by water (Holy Baptism), blood (His historical death), and the Spirit of God--not through any merely human success story about love--that John is able to write so encouragingly. The final success that really matters isn't a matter of trophies. It's unrelated to the number of accolades that you and I might receive from others. It's God's victory. God is the One who conquers. And God shares that victory with us!

This week, we talk about how God Tells His People How to Build the Tabernacle, Exodus 35:10–36:1-38.


