# More Than "Just Another Fish" in the Sea

## (1 Corinthians 12)

The month of January and the performance of yearly "firsts" (first department store sale, first dream, first shrine/temple visit, first calligraphy, and the list goes on!) are all a big deal in the country where I once lived: Japan. In addition to all of the family traditions that surround the celebration of a new calendar year in Japan, the hatsuseri is the first auction of bluefin tuna, held at the Toyosu fish market—the largest wholesale fish market in the world. This first auction is always, on the one hand, a bit of a publicity stunt. Bragging rights for claiming the first bluefin tuna of the year in 2019 were worth 334 million yen (almost three million dollars)! But the tradition of the first auction of the New Year in Japan and the attention it gathers is a kind of symbol of the nation's hopes for fishing conditions and economic possibilities throughout the rest of the year, too. A tuna fetching a high price at the inaugural January auction of the year is a symbol of the fish uncaught…yet hoped for, in 2022.

Jesus famously described the mission action of the church using the metaphor of fishing and catching fish. But the month of January provides an opportunity for all of us to focus not only on our call to fish as fishermen and women of our loving Savior. It is a chance to recognize our worth in God's eyes as fish once caught and paid for by God's Son, Jesus Christ! This month we will hear not only how we have received the gifts of God through Holy Baptism. We will see how each of us is a person through whom God actively is at work in His Church...how the Church is a little less than it would otherwise be when any one of us checks out, opts out, or drops out. St. Paul puts it like this: "Just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ.

It is good to state what those are, up front, right now, at the beginning of the year: (1) Mutual care among members of the RLC family that enhances our ability to grow spiritually and (2) our homes as key places where faith in Christ Jesus is nurtured. Monthly newsletter articles in 2022 will shine light on specific goals related to these two core values and how our life together enhances what God is already doing in these areas. I invite you to keep up with these articles, give us (myself, RLC staff, and the Church Council) your own feedback, and resolve to be a part of that ongoing conversation.

"There are plenty of other fish in the sea." It's a common expression signifying that when human relationships in one arena don't work out, there are always other options. I pray that every person reading this will understand the value he or she has in God's eyes. You mattered enough to God that He won and purchased you through the sacrifice of His own dear Son Jesus! You are more than "just another fish" in the sea, to Him. Let's do all we can in this year of our Lord 2022 to demonstrate that what mattered and continues to matter to God, matters to us, too.
