#### From the Pastor

## A Lord of Downward Mobility

#### (Philippians 2:5-11)

According to Merriam-Webster, the definition of "upward mobility" is "the capacity or facility for rising to a higher social or economic position." Economists use the term a lot. The goal for governments, educators, and a host of social institutions is to do all that is possible to see that folks better themselves... that as many people as possible gain more upward mobility over time. In the process, more and more folks are to make advances in physical/mental health, job opportunities, access to education, and are better able to flourish.

Upward mobility that benefits people in need is a wonderful, beautiful thing. But every year the season of gift-giving (and gift-buying) reveals



a darker side to the human aspiration to do more, be more, and get more. Ironically, it's the very time of year we turn our attention to the birth of Jesus, whom Christian author Henri Nouwen famously called the Lord of "downward mobility." Though

our culture is constantly beckoning us in the opposite direction, Jesus, in the words of St. Paul, "who, though he existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God as something to be grasped, but emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, assuming human likeness. And being found in appearance as a human, he humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death — even death on a cross." Jesus Christ, to rescue the world from sin and death, did not only, in the words of C. S. Lewis, "limit the thing most precious in the world to Him: His unhampered, unhindered communion with the Father."

## **CLI Prison Alliance**

The holidays and winter months can be especially lonely times for prison inmates. Our ministry through CLI Prison Alliance gives us the opportunity to provide materials that encourage, challenge, instruct, and help the incarcerated grow in faith. Consider donating Christian books you have read (soft and hardcover), gently used Bibles, CDs and DVDs. Large print materials and foreign language materials (especially Spanish) are acceptable but not oversized, spiral bound, or magazines. Add to your Christmas shopping list an item to donate. Place the donations in the special CLI wooden bin in the hallway under the coat rack.

At CLI, a stamp is placed inside each cover inviting inmates to take the next step by enrolling in one of the CLI Bible studies. After prison chaplains receive the books, they place them in the library or in hands of individuals. Last year CLI, this local ministry that distributes nationally and to select foreign prisons, sent 403,750 books and Bibles. This year to date, they have received notes from 29,067 men and women who have made decisions for Christ. All it takes is just one book to start someone on that path.
