ALL SAINTS FESTIVAL and THE COMMEMORATION OF THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED – November 2/3, we will celebrate the Festival of All Saints. In our worship, we will remember with thanksgiving all those who have received the blessing of Everlasting Life through faith in Jesus Christ.

On Sunday, November 3, special music by the Sanctuary Choir, Harmonia Deum, and the Resurrection Brass Ensemble, with festival settings of the hymns, will help us in our celebration.
