

The First Petition:
hallowed be
Thy name,

The Second Petition:
Thy kingdom come,

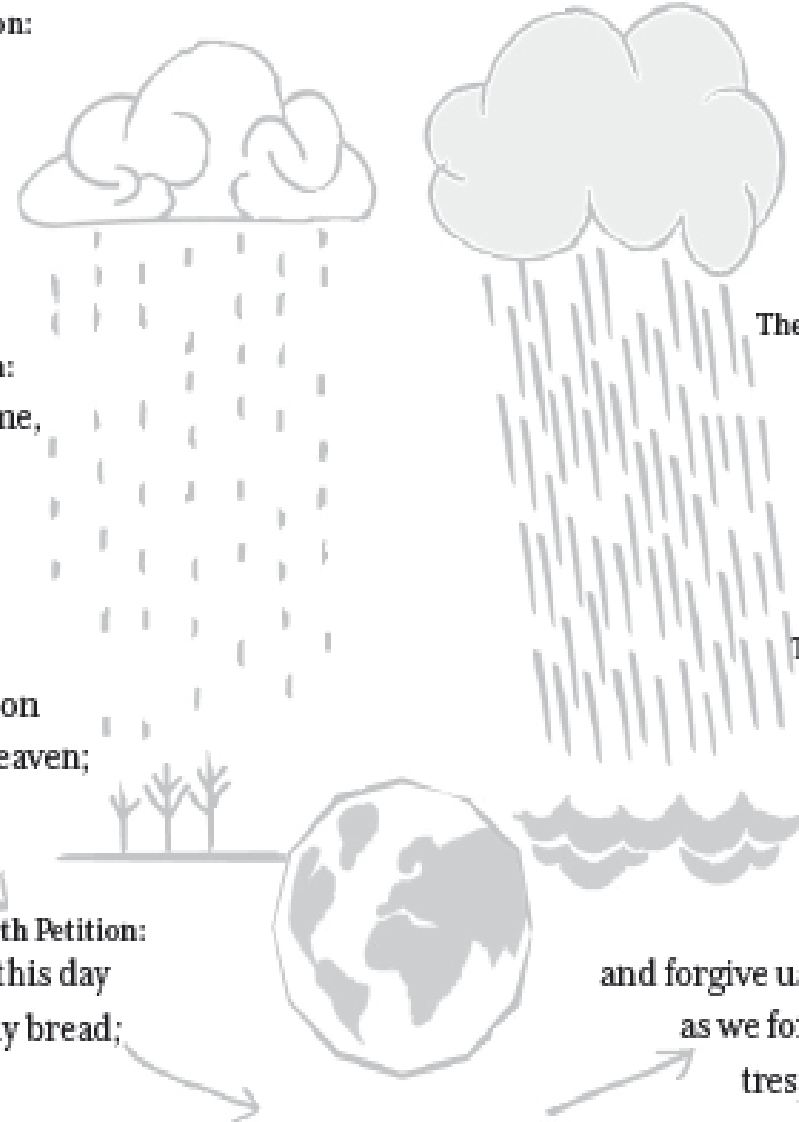
The Third Petition:
Thy will be done on
earth as it is in heaven;

The Fourth Petition:
give us this day
our daily bread;

The Seventh Petition:
but deliver
us from evil.

The Sixth Petition:
and lead us not
into temptation,

The Fifth Petition:
and forgive us our trespasses
as we forgive those who
trespass against us;



Make It Yours



- Large scale prayer
- Immediate prayer
- Take an exit, as needed, and linger on a petition



- The Lord's Prayer is united through each petition so that it leads you in a clear path;
- Strengthen your sense of being immediately with God in prayer;
- While this is a journey, savor each step as a fitting stop in itself

Coming to Our Father's Home



- Focus on God as Father and coming into His courts.
- No “window shade” prayers!!
- Join God in heaven through prayer



Finding Ourselves at Home

- Courthouse? Battlefield? Home!
- Pray boldly:
 - Proper understanding of our Father
 - Someone to bring us into His presence
 - And the words to say




Let the Journey Begin


