TUITION

\$450 per semester for fifteen 30-minute lessons.
\$675 per semester for fifteen 45-minute lessons.
\$225 per semester for fifteen 30-minute beginner group &
RLS Band/Orchestra group lessons.

Tuition is due either in full at the first lesson, or in two equal payments.

The first payment per semester is due on or before the first lesson, and the second on or before October 1st (fall); or March 1st (spring).

Music School Policies

Practice Policy

The value of each weekly lesson is fortified as students practice on their own. Each faculty member will share his/her expectations for practice between lessons with their students. Students who do not fulfill this responsibility may be dropped from enrollment.

Recital Policy

Sharing the music one is learning is a part of the lesson experience that contributes to a well-rounded music education. All students are expected to participate in the school's recitals. Exceptions are made for unavoidable schedule conflicts, or occasionally for a student whose teacher feels they are not quite ready for the public recital setting.

Attendance Policy

Students should be on time for lessons. If a lesson will be missed, notify your teacher as soon as possible, or if a last-minute emergency keeps you from a lesson, you may call the school at 919-851-7248, ext. 25 and leave a message.

Make-up Policy

One make-up date is offered each semester, during the week of Thanksgiving in the fall, and the last week of April in the spring. Student absences will not be made up beyond this one make-up.

Faculty Policies

Music School faculty are employed under contract which states, in part: [This faculty member] agrees to faithfully teach the fundamental skills associated with the instrument each student is studying, including basic musicianship using professionally accepted or standard methods or course books and quality literature. He/She agrees to conduct himself/herself in a professional and ethical manner as a faculty member of Resurrection Music School in his/her associations with students, parents, other faculty, RLC staff, and other persons with whom he/she comes in contact while teaching at Resurrection Music School.
